# PRESS RELEASE FOR THE PRELIMINARY RESULTS OF THE CARIBBEAN **PRIMARY EXIT ASSESSMENT (CPEA) 2024**

Grade 6 students registered for the 2024 Caribbean Primary Exit Assessment (CPEA) concluded their final examination on Thursday May 16th, 2024. Of the 1745 students registered, 1737 wrote the final examination.

Students' final scores were derived from the aggregate scores of both components of the CPEA. That is, the External Assessment which consisted of Multiple Choice Tests in Mathematics, Science, Language Arts Studies and from the School-Based Assessment which comprised a Project, a Writing Portfolio, a Book Report as well as Teacher Tests, Pupil Made Tests and Can-Do-Skills exercises in Mathematics, Science, Language Arts and Social Studies.

The preliminary results indicate that the proportion of students who met the prescribed standard was 1523 (87.68%), a slight increase over last year's 85.17%. This number includes 730 (84.2%) males and 793 (91.3%) females.
