**PRELIMINARY RESULTS OF THE MAY/JUNE
2026 CARIBBEAN SECONDARY EDUCATION CERTIFICATE (CSEC)
EXAMINATIONS**

Updated preliminary results of the May-June 2026 Caribbean Secondary Education Certificate (CSEC) Examinations were received on Monday, 31st August, 2026 in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. This year, 1996 candidates were registered. Of these, 1542 were school candidates and 454 were private candidates.

There were 1530 school candidates from 28 secondary schools sitting papers I and II with 10709 subject entries in 31 subject areas. Approximately 78.63% of the subject entries were awarded Grades I – III.

The largest entries were in English A (1393), Mathematics (1301), Social Studies (701) and Electronic Document Preparation and Management (677). The lowest entries were in Religious Education (28), Music (36) and Additional Mathematics (46).

This year, 20.60% of the passes were at Grade I level, 40.11% at Grade II and 39.28% at Grade III.

The subjects with the highest percentage pass were Physical Education and Sport (100%), Religious Education (100%), and Theatre Arts (98.31%). The subject with the lowest percentage pass was Mathematics (35.97%).

Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) subjects with the highest percentage pass were Food, Nutrition and Health (93.20%) and Industrial Technology (89.20%). The subjects with the lowest percentage pass were Textiles Clothing and Fashion (75.32%) and Technical Drawing (78.76%).

There were seven (7) schools which recorded percentage pass rates of 80% or more. These schools are:

Petit Bordel Secondary School (PBSS) and George Stephens Senior Secondary School (GSSSS) show improvement in their performance at the 2026 CSEC examinations. In 2025, PBSS recorded a pass rate of 54.31% and GSSSS recorded a pass rate of 53.90%. In 2026, PBSS pass rate increased to 72.50% and GSSSS pass rate rose to 66.25%. These figures represent an increase of 18.19% and 12.35% respectively.

The Ministry of Education congratulates all students and extends gratitude to the Principals, teachers and staff at all schools for their support of the students. We are cognizant of the fact that outcomes in education are measured, not only in quantitative terms, but also in qualitative terms; therefore, the value added to the lives of all of the students, the top performers as well as those whose performance can be improved, is greatly appreciated.

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
